WHAT DRIVER+ DELIVERS?

Driving Innovation in Crisis Management for European Resilience

- Large EU-funded project, GA 607798, May 2014 April 2020
- Trial Guidance Methodology Handbook
- a Pan-European Test-bed for Crisis Management Capability Building
- Portfolio of Solutions, many evaluated in DRIVER+ Trials
- Four trials (wildfires & cross-border cooperation; multi-hazard; flood & large scale logistics management; earthquake & volunteer management)

DRIVER+ OUTCOMES

Driving Innovation in Crisis Management for European Resilience

- Rich content: Trial Guidance Methodology Handbook, Portfolio of Solutions, List of Crisis Management gaps, ...
- Extensive networks of stakeholders: Four trials bringing together practitioners, solution providers, and researchers; a number of dedicated events
- Bridge between CM communities (e.g. Policy-Research Roundtable Dialogue, PRRD)
- Facilitator of innovation (Innovation for Crisis Management, I4CMs)
- How to sustain the momentum?

- Online community platform & face-to-face meetings to tackle challenges and facilitate the uptake of research and innovation






