





By collecting objective data in a realistic crisis management scenario and comparing the data from using innovative solutions to using state of the art tools.





COMPARING RESULTS/OBSERVATIONS TO REFERENCE DATA









The fixed unit can be any kind of **verified** reference.

It allows for analysis: Coin A is bigger than Coin B.

The SOPs did disturbed the use of the solutions functionality.

THE TRIAL DIMENSION

 THE INFLUENCE THE TRIAL ORGANISATION (LOGISTICS, AVAILABILITY OF KEY STAFF, HARDWARE, SOFTWARE, ETC.) HAS ON THE TRIAL.
